

## **Greenstone Settles Lawsuit over Anytime Anywhere Acquisition**

**New York, January 15th, 2009 – Greenstone Holdings, Inc (OTCPK: GSHN) announced today that** the Company and Messers Lopez and Griffin, pervious owners and the executives of the Company's inactive Anytime Anywhere disaster restoration service subsidiary, Anytime Anywhere Restoration Inc., settled a lawsuit pending in Supreme Court of the State of New York The settlement resolves a dispute between Messers Lopez and Griffin and Greenstone over acquisition and management of the Anytime Anywhere.
